

**Carnation Farmers Market
Non-Profit/Community Outreach Booths
2009 Overview and Application**

Each week at market we provide opportunity for Non-profit organizations, City of Carnation and municipality outreach programs to host a booth at the market to outreach to our market customers for the purpose of; 1) providing an opportunity for our customers to learn about local organizations; 2) supporting non-profits in our community; 3) providing a venue for cities and municipalities to educate the community about special projects and educational outreach efforts.

- Non-profit and community outreach booths will be assigned on a case by case basis, and should be reserved prior to market season in order to be added to the market calendar of events.
- Non-profits with a strong membership base or involvement in Snoqualmie Valley and those with educational outreach related to sustainability, farming, gardening, community and health will be prioritized.
- The Market will provide a 10x10 canopy (in some cases, with prior notice, this may be shared with another organization) and a 6' folding table. Participants must provide their own chairs, booth displays and garbage disposal.
- Fundraising efforts (such as raffle tickets, t-shirt and cookie sales) require permission of Market Manager and shall be limited to appropriate items which do not compete with regular market vendor sales, match the market ethic of healthy, local and organic, and are in accordance with the health code.
- Please see Market Policies and Guidelines, Section VI, available at at our info booth or www.carnationfarmersmarket.org for set-up, breakdown, etiquette and other applicable rules. Please read carefully.
- Non profit booth staff must arrive by 2:45 to set up their booth, and stay until 7:30 assisting with breakdown of their booth and other market amenities. If you wish to drive on site you must make prior arrangement and arrive in time to drive off site by 2:45.

We are located in Downtown Carnation, one block east of Hiway 203/Tolt Ave, at Bird St. (across from Millers and City Hall, next to the Hopelink Building).
